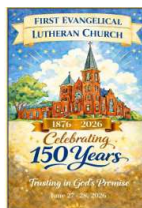

Why we sing *Holy, Holy, Holy! Lord God Almighty!* on Trinity Sunday is because few hymns so fully capture the wonder, mystery, and majesty at the heart of the Christian understanding of God. Written by Reginald Heber for Trinity Sunday and paired with John B. Dykes's tune NICAIA, named for the Council of Nicaea in 325 AD, the hymn was inspired by the Nicene Creed's affirmation of the full divinity of Christ and the mystery of "God in three persons," the text reminds us that the Trinity is not a puzzle to solve so much as a relationship of love into which we are drawn. Even while acknowledging that much about God remains beyond our understanding, the hymn insists that divine holiness is always joined to mercy, love, and grace. As we sing, we join a chorus that stretches across time, creation, and the communion of saints, reminding us that faith is ultimately an act of wonder, praise, and shared belonging.
